Parking on a Ramp



Do not park on a ramp unless absolutely necessary.

WARNING

- 1. Use the engine braking to help slow down the machine by letting up on the accelerator pedal.
- 2. Apply the brakes and bring the machine to a halt at the side of the road.
- 3. Turn the machine toward the rib.
- 4. If possible remove the load from the forks.
- 5. Apply the park brake. Observe that the brake head pressure gauge is on *zero*.
- 6. Always chock the wheels.
- 7. Inform mine management of the position of machine.



WARNING

When on steep grades (more than 1:4). Do not rely on the park brake to hold the machine.



Always park with forks into the rib and chock the wheels when on grades of more than 1:4.
